FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

As Nationals will be returning to the Trust Arena in 2020 we would like to take time to answer some questions we have received from the community.

Will the layout change next year?

The floor layout will stay the same. As majority of the Artistic equipment is required to be secured to the floor via floor plates (Anchor points drilled into the floor which are permanently set) we are limited to where we can place certain equipment. Floor plates must also sit outside of the Arenas show court creating further limitations.

Are we only going to award places 1-3?

In 2019 the decision was made to only present awards and e-certificates to places 1-3. We are currently reviewing this process and will communicate the outcome in the 2020 Nationals Newsletters.

Will the venue be heated next year?

The venue does not currently have an internal heating system available for our use. We will be looking into the option of portable heating for 2020.

Will there be more parking next year?

We are currently in discussion with the venue regarding potential over flow parking options.

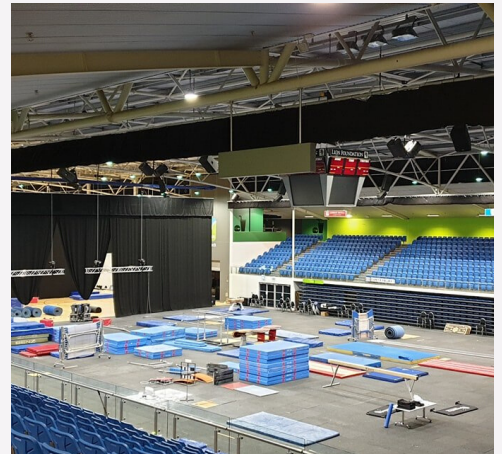
Where is Nationals to be held in the future?

Due to the large footprint of Nationals, the need for floor plates to be installed permanently into the Stadium floor (which is often not seen favorably by venues) to hold Artistic and the ability to create separate spaces to accommodate all five codes under the one roof we are currently limited to only a few venues in the country who can accommodate our event these are:

Trusts Arena, Auckland

Trustpower Arena, Tauranga

ILT Stadium Southland, Invercargill

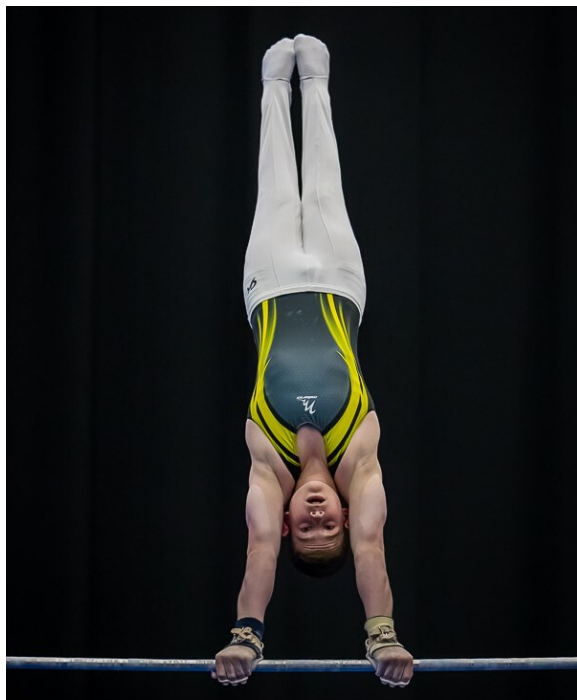

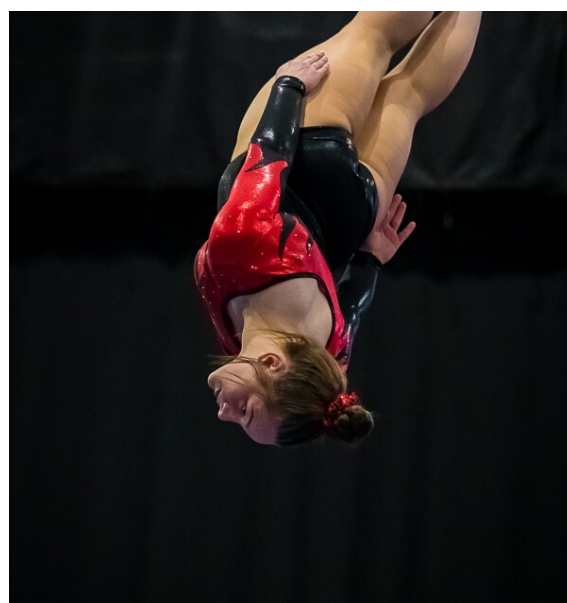


TRAMPOLINE TROPHIES

LOST AND FOUND

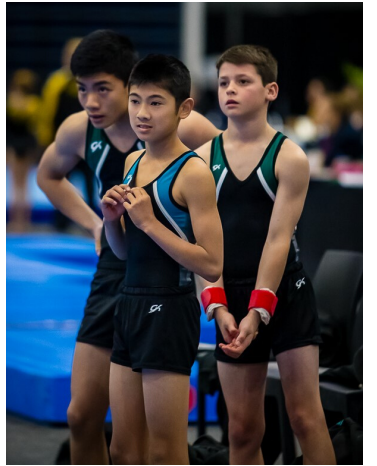
