

Men's Code of Points Final Version 2002 – 2004

All Code decisions take effect on May 1, 2002. The decisions regarding the number of vaults must first be ratified by the FIG Council and are expected to take effect on May 15, 2002. Regarding the apparatus height, you will receive an official information from the FIG Secretariat

The MTC reviewed the Code of Points questions after the World Championships in Ghent, BEL, and decided the followings. In the same time, we must mention that the list presented below also includes new element values announced in earlier Newsletters but gives the exact Code identification numbers. A complete document as a Code supplement will be prepared by the MTC.

General:

- • The MTC distinguished between attire deductions which are individual errors and can apply to each performance and Team Uniform deductions which are team errors and occur only once for a team per competition. In this respect, the Article 4.5 pages 7 - 8 will be updated under the Team violations section.
- • Moving the supplementary mat during an exercise is an apparatus related violations and 0.3 p. deductions will be applied from the final score (Article 4.5 page 7 – 8 « Apparatus related Violations »).

Floor Exercise:

- • Pg. 48, V. 11 Round Off = **A**.
- • All variants of forward saltos (tucked, picked or stretched) with 1/1 will be included in the same box and under the same number - Pg. 45, # 48 will move to # 43;
- • All variants of forward saltos (tucked, picked or stretched) with 3/2 turn will be included in the same box and under the same number - Pg. 45, # 58 and # 53 become together # 48;
- • Under **Lipskyi** name Pg.48 #20 - 1 ½ salto bwd. tucked or picked with 5/2 turn to roll fwd. = **E** and Pg. 49 #25 - Lipskyi stretched = **SE**.
- • Under **Tamayo** name Pg. 48 #5 – jump bwd. ½ turn to double salto fwd. stretched **SE**.
- • Under **Van Roon** name Pg. 45 #44 = 1 ½ salto fwd. tucked with 1/1 turn to roll fwd.= **D** .

Pommel Horse:

- • Pg. 52, Article 31 f. **The difficulty is increased one letter if the handstand travels 3/3 across the horse.**
- • Pg. 52, Article 31 g. iii - **The two types of combined elements may not follow each other directly. The second one will be recognized only if one or more elements are performed between them, of which at least one must be of minimum B-value and not be initiated or performed on a single pommel**
- • Pg. 58, II. 39 remove « with or without travel »

Rings:

- • The apparatus height is increased by 5 cm.
- • Pg. 77, # 30 Slow felge fwd. with straight body and arms to Swallow = E (without support phase)
- • Pg. 77, # 35 Raj Bhavsar, pull trough momentary front lever press to Maltese = **E**. Straight body = **SE**
- • Pg. 74, # 35 Honma direct (without support phase) to inverted cross = **E**. Straight body = **SE**.
- • Pg. 73, # 15 Front uprise directly to inverted cross = **D**, straight body = **E**.
- • Pg. 77, # 29 From cross, fwd. roll to cross straight arms and body (without support phase) = **D**

Vaults:

Number of Vaults – NEW RULE for both GAM and GAF

Competition I - Qualification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • • 1 vault except for those who wish to qualify for Vault Finals. • • They must vault twice under conditions identical with the rules for Vault Finals • • Gymnasts must declare their intention at the time that the Start Order lists are submitted • • The first vault will count towards Team and All Around. The second vault will be averaged with the first for qualification for Vault Finals.
Competition II - All Around Final	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • • 1 vault
Competition IV -Team Final	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • • 1 vault
Competition III - Vault Final	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • • 2 vaults

- • Pg.89 # 33 Handspring salto fwd. tucked with ½ turn and salto bwd., Zimmermann = **10 p.**
- • Pg.89 # 28 Dragulescu replace the name Xiao.
- • Pg.89 # 36 Handspring salto fwd. stretched with 2/1 turn = **9.90 p.**
- • Pg.88 # 19 Handspring salto fwd. stretched with 1/1 turn = **9.50 p.**
- • Pg.92 # 5 Yurchenko stretched with 5/2 turn = **9.90 p.**
- • Pg.92 # 15 become # 14 Melissanidis tucked but keeping the same start value = **9.80 p.**
- • Pg.92 # 15 **Melissanidis** picked = **10 p.**

Parallel Bars:

- • The apparatus height is increased by 5 cm.
- • Pg. 98 # 20 **Correction** - Pegan to hdst. "**on one rail**"
- • Pg. 99 # 24 **Correction** - Makuts = $\frac{3}{4}$ Diamidov and " $\frac{1}{4}$ Healy" to support
- • Pg.100 #46 Stutzkehre bwd. to support = move to **B** under # 47;
- • Pg.100 #47 Novikov = move to **C** under # 48;
- • Pg.100 #48 Healy = move to **D** under # 49;
- • Pg.100 #49 From hdst. on one rail Healy or Healy with $\frac{1}{4}$ turn = move to **E** under # 50.
- • Pg.103 #10 Fwd. uprise with $\frac{3}{4}$ Diamidov and $\frac{1}{4}$ Healy to support, **Tsolakidis = E**;
- • Pg.104 # 31 Bwd. uprise and strad.cut or flank over to support become # 37 = **B**;
- • Pg.104 # 37 Bwd. uprise and salto fwd.p. to support become # 38 = **C**;
- • Pd.104 # 38 Yamawaki become # 39 = **D**;
- • Pg.106 #44 Giant swing bwd. with $\frac{1}{1}$ turn - cancel the bottom picture. Giant swing with $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2}$ turn = **C + A**. To fulfill **the D** value requirement **only Giant Diamidov - $\frac{1}{1}$ turn** will be taken into consideration.

Horizontal Bar:

- • The apparatus height is increased by 5 cm.
- • Pg.118 # 24 Zou Li Min move to #28 with new value = **C**;
- • Pg.122 # 48 Czech giant to Tkachev = **C**;
- • Pg.122 # 55 Kolman stretched under the name **Cassina = SE**;
- • Pg.123 # 63 Stalder $\frac{1}{2}$ turn to immediate rear vault to hang = **C**.

The FIG Executive Committee has approved these changes to the Code which are in accordance with its guidelines. No other changes will be made during this cycle.
